Welcome/Introductions/Minutes Approval

Chairperson Brennan welcomed the group. Minutes from the March 2016 meeting were approved.

KACI Overview

Sharon Brennan and Donna discussed the responsibilities of serving on the KACI committee for new members.

KTIP Numbers/Goal

KTIP update: there are 5 fall intern, 1,405 full year interns, 44 denied, 361 incomplete and 1 resign. Of the 44 denied none were due to budget. The goal this year is to enroll all interns (none denied due to budget).

Appeals

There were 8 unsuccessful, 3 appeals, 2 nullified and 1 upheld.

Regulation Status

At the last board meeting (August 15, 2016) a draft of the regulation was reviewed and approved. The regulation will now move to the legislature. In a couple of weeks Donna will attend a legislative education committee meeting to answer questions or concerns they may have regarding the draft. In the meantime, a waiver is in place until the regulation goes through the approval process.

Resources

The MSD addendum, Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education (IECE) Training PowerPoint, and the District KTIP Coordinator PowerPoint are now available on the EPSB website.

KDE Peer Observer training:

The KDE peer observation training has been revised and can be accessed on KDE's website. The training is a deep-dive into the Kentucky Framework for Teaching. KTIP committee members and interns should utilize this training to better understand the framework, materials, and available resources.

DC Meetings: Sharon and Sherri conducted three District Coordinator trainings this summer. The trainings took place in Corbin, Muhlenberg County, and EPSB. A total of 59 coordinators attended.

Atlas: The National Board online teaching library. Donna has access to several ATLAS licenses through the NT3 grant. If anyone on the committee (KACI) would like to participate in a KTIP pilot using ATLAS with their interns, contact Donna.

Examples Online

Due to the low number submitted last year, source of evidence examples have not been put online. Plans are to continue to collect examples from interns and bring a committee together to select and categorize examples to post next year (2017-18 school year).

Globally Comp Teaching Pilot

Sharon Brennan presented a short documentary and provided information from the NAFSA Teacher Educator Colloquia. She asked for the committee's approval to explore a pilot and it was approved.

Feedback

Feedback was provided by KACI members regarding the summer training for KTIP committee members.

Retiree Recognition

Dick Roberts from Western Kentucky University was recognized and presented a plaque for his many years of service with KTIP. Winona Griggs from Wayne County Schools was also recognized for her service with the KACI committee.
